**FIRE BAN IN EFFECT FOR ALL
UNINCORPORATED
LAKE COUNTY**

Starting June 15th, 2018 at 6:00 AM.

STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTION.

Stage I: The following acts are prohibited on **all unincorporated land, roads and trails described herein**, until further notice:

- Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire. This includes charcoal.
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials.
- No fireworks.

Exemptions:

- Camp fires on private property in pits made of metal, masonry or concrete
- Camp fires in developed campgrounds.
- Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.
- Persons using a fire solely fueled by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels.
- Persons conducting activities in those designated areas where the activity is specifically authorized by written posted notice.
- Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- Public firework displays approved by Sheriff/Fire Chief
