Winter Trails –

Talk of a dedicated Nordic Ski Council as there is interested among some dedicated folks.

Got an Atlas tracker for one groomer to see test realtime grooming updates.

Need to decide where to increase parking, and then find the property owner to see if a letter could work to increase the area.

Single Track Trails – New trails proposed overlapped with a logging permit so some new locations are being scouted. The Cloud City Wheelers now has a paid employee to help guide the effort.

Directors Report – Adult Soccer will be offered in the summer. Need to get the word out at the High and Tight and the new Grocery store downtown. Kids Yoga will be offered this summer as well. Potential for a photography class led by Steve Sunday. The program guide will move to an annual schedule instead of biannual. Dates and Times will be more flexible and the program would point to online resources/phone numbers to find this information. Closer to program dates more program specific flyers will be used. Some electrical was upgraded in the pump room to remove corroded outlets, provide better grounding. Roger plans to start clearing the MBT on May 14. Turquoise to start getting cleared around May 23. The school district has started a facilities master plan with potential momentum for Federico Field this fall. Track is the number one priority. Talk of lighting/seating options as well. New online program registration should be up in June.

Treasurers Report – MBT resurfacing should be closer to 22,000 instead of 28,000. Scheduled for Monday June 11th. 2 day closure. Also some shoulder work is planned.

Aquatic Center Board:

Outreach: Aquatic center survey will be focused on the users first and then opened to the broader community.
